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1. Introduction - General information about challenges in Education and the role to be served by National Examination Gateway towards the Vision 2020

Rwanda is a country in the process of branding itself as the information and technology hub in Africa. Despite incredible progress towards this vision, many challenges still remain. One of challenges is the absence of a viable cyber educational infrastructure supporting students while preparing for National Exams. Students in the final year of primary school, secondary school ordinary level and advanced level still face numerous challenges while revising school material especially when preparing for national examinations. Another challenge is that although we have outstanding progress regarding the growth and the expansion of the ICT industry, Rwanda still has many miles to go to fully position ourselves in the region as the Silicon Valley of the East African Community. One of the crucial key indicators would be the number of Rwandan tech companies operating in the entire East African Community region, which is extremely deplorable. National Examination Gateway is a perfect fit in approaching both challenges by both creating a local solution and establishing an East African wide tech company. Our vision is not only to create a platform that will solve Rwandan problems in building a comprehensive national exams preparation platform using ICT, but also to implement a scalable platform that will be of use in the entire East African Community region as exam preparation is a challenge that we all share. The platform will house past exams, practice exams, education materials to assist students not only in the national exam preparation process, but also in their entire learning experience. Doing so will allow us to join hands with the government of Rwanda initiatives in improving the quality education, contributing in the achievement of our vision 2020 and establishing an ICT in education solution that will serve as one of the foundations as Rwanda becomes the Silicon Valley of the East African Community.

2. Problem - Lack of a comprehensive educational preparation infrastructure

In 2010, the republic of Rwanda introduced a 12 years basic education whereby every child in Rwanda must undergo a 12 years education program comprised of six years of primary school and six years of secondary education. During these 12 years mandatory education, students will undergo three national examinations, statewide standardized examinations administered by Rwanda Education Board, a government body under the ministry of education. The problem that many students currently face is the lack of appropriate preparation material which gives some

more advantages than others. Students are challenged in accessing past exams, practice exams, appropriate mentorship and many other preparation necessities.

3. Solution - National Examination Gateway and its products and services

National Examination Gateway came in place to assist students as they revise their educational material, but more importantly during the time when they prepare for national exams. The learning and practice material will be accessed both online and offline as we understand that many of the Rwandan students still have access to internet. The platform will house educational material, past exams and solutions, practice tests, and other learning and exam preparation resources. In addition, we will provide an infrastructure that connects learners and educators both online and offline.

4. Motivation/Philosophy - Empowering the minds, Brightening the future

A desire to make a difference, to use our talents and skills in solving problems and build a stronger educational support platform is what drives National Examination Gateway. We share a common belief that by empowering the people by equipping them with quality education, we will be contributing in making the future brighter hence national Examination Gateway motto: "empowering the minds, brightening the future".
